**Czech Sprint Orienteering Championship (CSOC)
(a part of long-term competitions: Continental Cup, HI-TEC Sprint Cup, HSH Ranking
the coefficient 1,10)**

and

**Czech Masters Sprint Orienteering Championship (CMSOC)
(a part of The Czech Masters Cup)**

- Organizer:** Orienteering Club Třebíč - TTR
- Date:** 4th June 2005
- Event Centre:** Karlovo Square, Třebíč
- Assembly point:** Ice hockey stadium Třebíč; 1, Kateřiny z Valdštejna Street (indoor area – registration, changing area in the auditorium, toilets, wash rooms, refreshments). We ask you to keep tidiness.
Entering the playing area is strictly forbidden!
- Registration:** 8.30 – 10.00:00, at the assembly point at the ice-hockey stadium
- Arrival:** all participants are asked to respect arrival routes from particular directions so that they can avoid possible problems related to the traffic situation in the centre of the town – see the street maps on the event www page
- Winning times:** anticipated winner's time - 15 minutes
- Closed pre-start area:** - the route is marked by green-white streamers – see the centre plan.
Competitors of categories HD 21,16,18,20 are obliged to take numbers according to the start list - self-service.
In the area there will be available: check points descriptions, sellotape, scissors, drinking water, toilets
Competitors have to enter the closed area by the set time!
- Timetable:** **competitors of categories HD 21** have to register at the closed area from 10:40 to 10:55 and take their numbers. After passing the start corridors (clear and check corridors) they start from a platform where they get a map at the time of their start and where there is the finish too.
- competitors of categories HD16,18,20** have to register at the closed area from 12:05 to 12:25 and take their numbers. After passing the start corridors (clear and check corridors) they start in front of the platform and they take their maps at the compulsory lap.

masters categories are obliged to pass through the closed area. After passing the start corridors (clear and check corridors) they start in front of the platform and they take their maps at the compulsory lap.

All competitors will be checked in the start corridors for not using the spikes!

Check-points descriptions:

All categories have their descriptions on their maps. Moreover, they can take the printed descriptions in the closed area (tape & scissors available).

Start numbers: - are compulsory for all competitors of the categories HD 21, 16, 18, 20
Competitors of the categories HD 21 have to return the start numbers immediately after the race.

Punching system: - electronic Sport-Ident system for all classes
- one single card must not be used twice in the competition
- in case of SI failure there are R squares on the map

Time 000: 11:00, individual start

Distances: parking area - assembly point: 0 – 300 m (yellow streamers)
assembly point – event centre: 800 m (blue-white streamers)
event centre - start centre: 200 m
event centre – finish: 0 m

Map: Třebíč, scale 1:4 000, E 2 m, situation – May 2005, map size: 420x297,
mapmaker: Petr Hranička,
waterproof cover

The race area: the compulsory lap is marked in the check-points descriptions

Handing in the maps: in the finish area, until **15:50**

Results: continual results will be published in the event centre

Prize giving: **14: 00** - three best competitors of all championship categories
16.40 - three best competitors of all masters categories

Time limit: 60 minutes

Finish closing time: 17.00

Terrain: a historic town neighbourhood, a town wood and a park, partially historic pavement (cobblestones); south and south-east scarps of the river valley are partly covered in acacia trees.

The traffic in the town centre is partially restricted. However, the race routes cross streets with traffic. All competitors are asked (and warned) to be careful!

Restrictions: - usage of spikes is forbidden; otherwise, the competitor will not be allowed to take part in the race
All competitors will be checked in the start corridors for not using the spikes!

Toilets: - toilets at the ice hockey stadium available
- public conveniences in the event centre – free usage after presenting your SI card
-mobile toilets in the closed pre-start area

Refreshments: - restaurant at the ice-hockey stadium
- snack bars on Charles Square
- restaurants on Charles Square and its surroundings (about 15 rest.)

Medical service: at the event centre

Notes: - parking according to organizers' instructions at the designated areas
- entering marked private areas is strictly prohibited
- selling and advertising activities are possible only with permission of the event director or of the event main supervisor
- protest deposit: CZK 200
Taking part in the competition at your own risk!

Information of interest:

We recommend visiting the St. Prokopius Basilica, the Jewish Synagogue, (since 2003 listed in the UNESCO register) and the Town Tower. Free tickets for all these sights will be provided at the registration.

The St. Prokopius Basilica may be visited in any time of the day until 17:00, the other two sights after the competition (the competition restricted area!) until 18:00.

The music festival „Záměstí 2005“ is held from 3th – 4th June 2005 in Třebíč (see www.zamosti.cz)
